**Literacy:** As aspiring readers and writers, we will:

- we will continue to learn new Set 3 sounds
- we will learn grammar of past tense, apostrophe, capital letters, suffixes for verbs -ing, -ed, er, adjectives -er and -est, prefix un- and plurals -s and -es.
- we will write narratives and narratives in the aspects of a different character, write lost poster, write about the Gingerbread Man, and write about feelings when we fall out.
