What was it like to live in Ancient Greece?

Literacy: As aspiring readers and writers, we will:



We will be basing our learning this term on Greek myths and legends. We will be writing stories, poetry, information texts and a biography. We will also be building on our skills in Grammar, Sentence structure, writing and reading.

Maths: As aspiring mathematicians, we will:

In Maths, we will exploring fractions: recognising fractions, equivalent fractions and adding and subtracting fractions.

We will also continue to develop our understanding of Times Tables, shape, measurement, money and time.

In Science, we will be investigating animals including humans. We will describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans, identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions and construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.

In this unit about ancient Greece, we will gain an understanding of where and when some key events during the ancient Greek period took place. We will explore what is meant by the terms 'trade', 'civilisation' and 'empire' and explore how, towards the end of the ancient Greek period, Alexander the Great grew an empire resulting in the Greek civilisation spreading more widely. When learning about daily life in ancient Greece, we will explore what life was like for different people who were enslaved during ancient Greek times.

We will also continue our exploration of the Islamic faith, worship and Festivals.
